NOTICE OF INTENTION**

TINRYLAND VILLAGE

Carlow County Council wishes to give notice of its intention to temporarily close the following roads to facilitate Tinryland Village Half Marathon on **Saturday 2nd of May 2026 between the hours of 10:00am & 2:00pm.**

L-1023 Nurney Road

L-3051 O'Reilly's Crossroads to Ballybar Crossroads to Tinryland Crossroads

L-3050 Ballyloo Crossroads to O'Reilly's Cross

L-3052 Tinryland to Ballyloo Crossroads.

Local diversion routes will be in place.

Alternative Route Maps

The following section details the alternative routes available at each junction:

The red line indicates the race route, while the blue line indicates alternative routes. The M9 motorway between junction 5 and junction 6 will also allow for alternative routes. There will be signs placed at each of these junctions at least 14 days prior to the event informing motorists of the road closure.

Turn One

Marshalls will be present at both the Moat Hill and Kane's cross to direct traffic to alternative routes via N80 or via Rathcroogue




Turn Two

Marshalls will be present at both the Motorway hill turn heading towards ballinacarrig and they can access the N80 or Kilkenny road




Turn Three

Marshalls will be present at both O'Reilly's cross and Clonmelsh junction informing motorists of the road closure and diverting them to alternative routes via clonmelsh, bagenalstown or the Quinagh road

Marshalls will be present at Ballyloo cross to inform motorists of the road closure and divert them either the Nurney road or the Ballybar upper road towards the N80 and Tullow
