Introduction


- The data in this report is based on preliminary reports from An Garda Síochána, based on information current as of 18 July 2023.






Fatalities

2021 and 2022

- As of 31 December 2022, there have been 149 fatal collisions, which have resulted in 155 fatalities on Irish roads.
- This represents 25 more fatal collisions and 19 more deaths (+4%) compared to provisional Garda data for 2021.








Road user profile of fatalities








Age group of fatalities
