## 7.0 Notices of Motion/Fógraí Rúin

7.1 Standing in the Names of Cllrs. K Murnane, W Paton, A. Dalton, F Phelan, M Doran, B O'Donoghue, J Cassin, A. McDonald, A. Wallace, J. McDonald & J. Pender

#### "Noting:

- (i) That Carlow Women's Aid have offered an efficient and high standard of service to Carlow town and county both in the centre and through their outreach work for over 20 years and
- (ii) That Carlow Women's Aid lobbied Minister Zappone for funding for two domestic violence outreach workers to be based in Carlow town.

That this Council expresses its complete and utter disappointment at the decision of Tusla to base two domestic violence outreach workers to Amber, Kilkenny and call on Tusla to base at least one domestic violence outreach worker in Carlow Women's Aid in Carlow Town."

### 7.2 Standing in the Name of Cllr. Ken Murnane

"That the members of Carlow County Council call the next Government for a commitment to allocate ten acres of land, from the land aggregation scheme in Carlow Town, to Carlow County Council. This will allow Carlow County Council to offer Carlow people access to an affordable housing scheme. This affordable housing option has been promised to the Irish people for many years now."

#### 7.3 Standing in the Name of Cllr. Willie Quinn

"That Carlow County Council invites Coillte and its consultants Fehily Timoney and Co. to the March meeting of Carlow County Council to discuss the upcoming planning application for Croaghaun wind farm on the Blackstairs Mountains. This planning application has not been lodged with Carlow County Council planning section. There are serious concerns regarding the Tourist Industry and also the local residents in the area. The proposed 7 Turbine wind Farm will be the highest ever erected in Ireland and will stand at 182 metres in height, this is 60 metres higher than the spire in Dublin. As the bases for such structures would be very big, there are major concerns with regards to land slides into the future and also the major damage to the road structure with all the heavy construction vehicles that will be needed to construct this wind farm. This is public land and it is the public who should decide not Government agencies."
