"Carlow County Council to engage with Kildare County Council to formulate a submission to the department of Transport to provide safe parking on the entrance and exit of the M9 motorway at junction 5. To ensure as part of the submission the lights are switched back on at the same junction on the motorway."

"This motion calls on Carlow County Council to write to the Department of Transport and the RSA to ask them to address the very serious and unacceptable waiting times for a Driving Test in County Carlow. Constituents are waiting around 7 months to be given a test from the time they apply. This has very serious impacts on our learner drivers varying from additional cost of insurance due to being on a Learner's Permit to inability to take up employment due to lack of Full Drivers License.

This motion calls on the Department to give approval for the employment of additional Driving Testers and a review of the operating hours so that more tests could be carried out on the weekend or in the evenings to help alleviate the backlog."
