6.0 Notices of Motion/Fógraí Rúin

6.1 Standing in the Name of Cllr. Fintan Phelan

'We, the members of Carlow County Council, support the introduction of public drinking water fountains in Carlow Town and County. Ireland is amongst Europe's top producers of plastic waste and many plastic bottles are not recycled and end up in landfill. The ability to reflill your bottle in public spaces will help combat plastic waste, will be cost effective for individuals and will enhance our public spaces.'

6.2 Standing in the name of Cllr. Adrienne Wallace

"That this council launch an extensive report detailing how a license was issued by the council to the Puppy Farm at Raheenleigh, Myshall six months before it was closed down as a result of the extreme neglect and abuse of the animals there. The report should list any future recommendations needed to ensure a more thorough process for granting licenses is in place."

6.3 Standing in the name of Cllr. Adrienne Wallace

"That this council, in the name of transparency and accountability,

introduce the on-line streaming of Carlow county council meetings in order to ensure increased accessibility for the wider public. A report on the progress of this service should be given at the December county council meeting."

6.4 Standing in the Name of Cllr. John Cassin

"Carlow County Council calls on the Minister for health Simon Harris to provide St Luke's Hospital Kilkenny (serving the people of Carlow and Kilkenny) with the necessary funding for the Life Saving MRI scanner as a matter of urgency this needs to be addressed immediately."

"Carlow County Council calls on the Minister for health, Simon Harris to immediately respond and provide the necessary funding to the Ambulance crisis in Carlow. The waiting time for an ambulance to arrive after an emergency call, is completely unacceptable and Carlow peoples lives are at risk."
