5.1 Standing in the name of Cllr. William Quinn

"I am calling on The Executive to clarify the procedures involved in the Part VIII planning process, the input from the various sections and the decision making process to determine whether or not to proceed to Part VIII and particularly how from elected members input into this process"

5.2 Standing in the name of Cllr. William Quinn

"I am calling on the Government to ensure that no frontline workers will have to cover the cost of a private Covid 19 test in order to travel home within Ireland to spend time with their families at Christmas if restrictions have been lifted."

5.3 Standing in the name of Cllr Adrienne Wallace and Cllr. John Cassin

"That this council immediately write to the Government to demand that they unseal the files from the Mother and Baby Homes commission. This council should also outline in its correspondence that such a blanket denial of access to personal data undermines the purpose of this Commission, which was to respond to complaints of unlawful interference with private and family life, denial of personal and family identity, and denial of information about loved ones who have disappeared or deceased. Furthermore, this council should note that the Commission's denial of GDPR rights for the past two years does not mean that further denial of them by the Government is justified: it means that rectifying the situation is all the more urgent. This should be dealt with in accordance with the GDPR which provides a plethora of rights giving a person control over how their personal data is used. A copy of this motion should also be sent to every local authority in Ireland, north and south, as correspondence."

5.4 Standing in the name of Cllr. Adrienne Wallace

"This council will write to Tulsa to call for Tusla representatives to attend a meeting with the elected members of Carlow Council to discuss plans for a women's refuge here. Noting the huge surge in Domestic Violence during the last lockdown we must act now to ensure women and children experiencing domestic violence have the resources they need in their community. This meeting can take place online or in person."

5.5 Standing in the Name of Cllr. Fintan Phelan

"That Carlow County Council promote and advance the awarding of the recommended 5 Military Medals for Gallantry and the 27 Distinguished Service Medals for the Irish Soldiers of A Company 35th Infantry Battalion who so bravely defended the Siege of Jadotville, serving under a UN mandate in the DRC.

Although they were recognised in 2017 by the Government with a block Jadotville Medal, the Gallantry and Distinguished Service medals continue to be denied. A letter from Carlow County Council to the Minister of Defence and our Commander in Chief, the President, be drafted accordingly and dispatched forthwith."
