RESPONSE:

MapAlerter.ie is a free service that delivers localized alerts and notifications from most local authorities across Ireland. Members of the public can receive SMS, email and app notifications for water disruptions, road works, floods, planning activity, severe weather and other topics that may impact them. A link to MapAlerter for Carlow County Council is located at the bottom of all Carlow County Council webpages including its homepage, carlow.ie. Mapalerter is a free to use service and members of the public can register for alerts at mapalerter.com. Carlow County Council operates a 24 hour call answering service including an out of hours call answering service for all non fire or other life critical emergencies, (059 9170300), this number is published at the top of all Council webpages including the homepage of Carlow County Council. To contact any of the emergency services including the Fire and Rescue Service, An Garda Síochána, HSE or Coastguard, members of the public should dial 999 or 112 without exception.

The National Directorate for Fire and Emergency Management (NDFEM) works closely with Met Éireann, the OPW, all Local Authorities, other Government Departments and agencies to monitor weather forecasts and their predicted impacts both locally and nationally. During periods of predicted Severe Weather, briefings are held with the NDFEM's Crisis Management Teams and Carlow County Council's Severe Weather Assessment Team (SWAT). If it is predicted that severe weather may potentially have a significant impact on Carlow County Council's functional area a team dedicated to the Council's severe weather response is established. A dedicated severe weather contact number is established and publicised widely on local media as well as on the Council's social media pages
