6.1 Standing in the name of Cllr. Ben Ward

"That Carlow County Council write to the Minister for Transport, TFI, and Bus Eireann seeking an update on the expansion of rural public transport services across county Carlow. In particular, the introduction of services to Ardattin and Clonegal."

6.2 Standing in the name of Cllr. Ben Ward

"That Carlow County Council urgently take action on implementing the funding received in February for a bus stop enhancement programme across the county"

6.3 Standing in the name of Cllr. Fergal Browne

"That Carlow County Council call for reform for those wishing to contest future presidential elections to include to separate date for nominations by the oireachtas and local authorities and a move away from councils needing to back candidates and instead individual county councillors being allowed to nominate candidates once minimum number reached."

6.4 Standing in the name of Cllr. Fintan Phelan

"That Carlow County Council write to Iarnród Éireann (Irish Rail) requesting that they urgently explore options to increase car parking capacity at Carlow Train Station.

Given that the existing car park is consistently at full capacity by the time of the 7:56 a.m. train, many commuters and rail users are unable to avail of parking thereafter. This is causing significant inconvenience and stress for individuals travelling to Dublin and other destinations for work, education, medical appointments, and leisure.

The Council should engage with Irish Rail and all relevant stakeholders to identify and examine potential short-, medium-, and long-term solutions, including additional or alternative parking options to support increased demand at the station."

6.5 Standing in the name of Cllr. Adrienne Wallace

Noting the essential work that healthcare staff play in society, and particularly here in Carlow, this Council will write to Caredoc to request they implement the agreed 8% pay uplift arising from a WRC agreement in 2023 to their workers. In addition, this council stands in solidarity with the workers from Caredoc who were forced to protest on Wednesday the 26th and who voted to begin a strike in December if their request for a pay uplift is not met.
